- 1. Fill out this form to indicate your interest in participating. CLICK HERE
- 2. You will be contacted by someone from our partner, CombinedBrain to set up a time to review the program with you and have blood draw kits sent to your home address.
 - You will be required to submit a genetic report to participate.
 - We will help you create a CRID (unique universal ID for patients involved in clinical research so that your name/identifying information is not attached to your samples).
 - Informed consents must be signed.
 - Unaffected parents and/or siblings are encouraged but not required to submit blood samples as controls.
 - All data is de-identified and protected by each organization's IRB.
- 3. When you receive the blood draw kits, take them to a lab or to your doctor for a blood draw. You should wait until you need a blood draw for another purpose and then add these tubes on, so it's just one needle stick! Home services are available in some areas.
- 4) Send samples back using the prepaid label. That's it!
