To provide a global rating of illness severity, improvement and response to treatment.

The CGI is rated on a 7-point scale, with the severity of illness scale using a range of responses from 1 (normal) through to 7 (amongst the most severely ill patients).

CGI-C scores range from 1 (very much improved) through to 7 (very much worse).

### **Treatment response**

Ratings should take account of both therapeutic efficacy and treatment-related adverse events and range from 0 (marked improvement and no side-effects) and 4 (unchanged or worse and side-effects outweigh the therapeutic effects). Each component of the CGI is rated separately; the instrument does not yield a global score.

### **Severity of illness: Considering your total clinical experience with this particular population, how mentally ill is the patient at this time?**

0 = Not assessed

1 = Normal, not at all ill

2 = Borderline mentally ill

3 = Mildly ill

4 = Moderately ill

5 = Markedly ill

6 = Severely ill

7 = Among the most extremely

### **Global Improvement: Rate total improvement whether or not, in your judgement, it is due entirely to drug treatment. Compared to his condition at admission to the project, how much has he changed?**

0 = Not assessed

1 = Very much improved

2 = Much improved

3 = Minimally improved

4 = No change

5 = Minimally worse

6 = Much worse

7 = Very much worse

**Efficacy Index:** Choose the letter from the matrix which best describe the degrees of therapeutic effect and side effects and record the letter from the matrix where the two items intersect. (Rate this item on the basis of drug effect only.)

**Therapeutic Effect options:**

**Marked** = Vast improvement, Complete or nearly complete remission of all symptoms

**Moderate** = Decided improvement, Partial remission of symptoms

**Minimal** = Slight improvement which doesn't alter status of care of patient

**Unchanged or worse**
